Using the tools of meditation, prayer and contemplation, focus on your breathing and allow stillness to surround the anxiety.

Choose a conversation partner to share your concerns, reflect on how the polarization we recognize in the political fragmentation around us may be internalized into a sense of worry, accelerated by isolation. We become more deeply convinced of the grave state of polarization around us, forgetting that we can choose another way.

Break open your own experience to the healing that can be found in naming and taming anxiety by giving it voice, releasing it, and taking a step towards believing that something else is possible.
